David Garvin, M.S.W., a seasoned BISC-MI professional, will present appropriate tools to be used to address the various tactics to identify and explain the differences between anger management and domestic violence treatment.

This training is for new BISC-MI providers as well as seasoned providers who want to learn or revisit tools used in groups. The fall training will provide service professionals with added insight into batterer intervention strategies. Probation officers, victim advocates, clergy, medical and judicial personnel and other related professionals will gain an understanding of what should be occurring at their local batterer intervention service agencies. This training will offer the tools to deal with the batterer with different professional settings and assessment tools that will separate the need for domestic violence treatment or anger management.

DIRECTIONS
