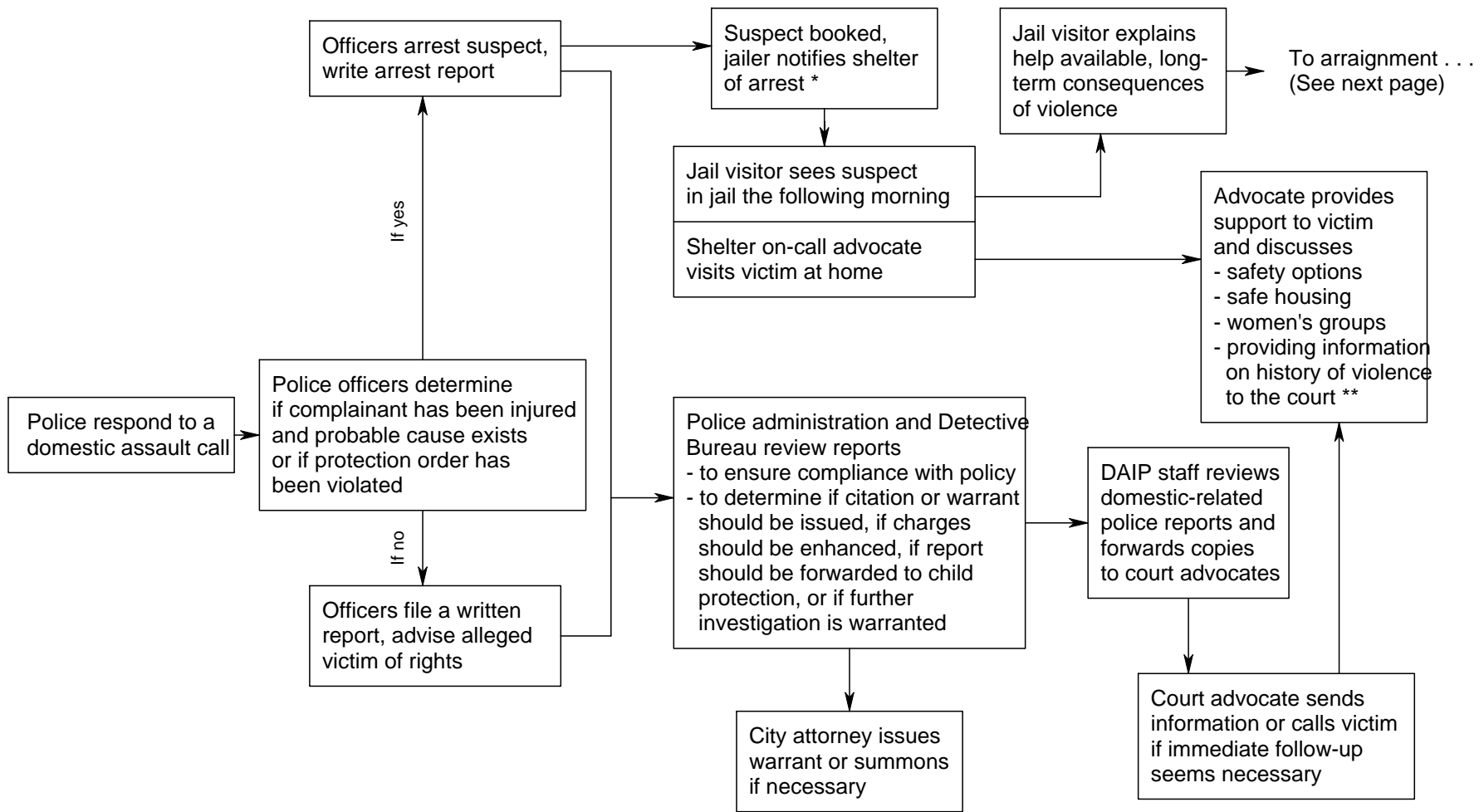


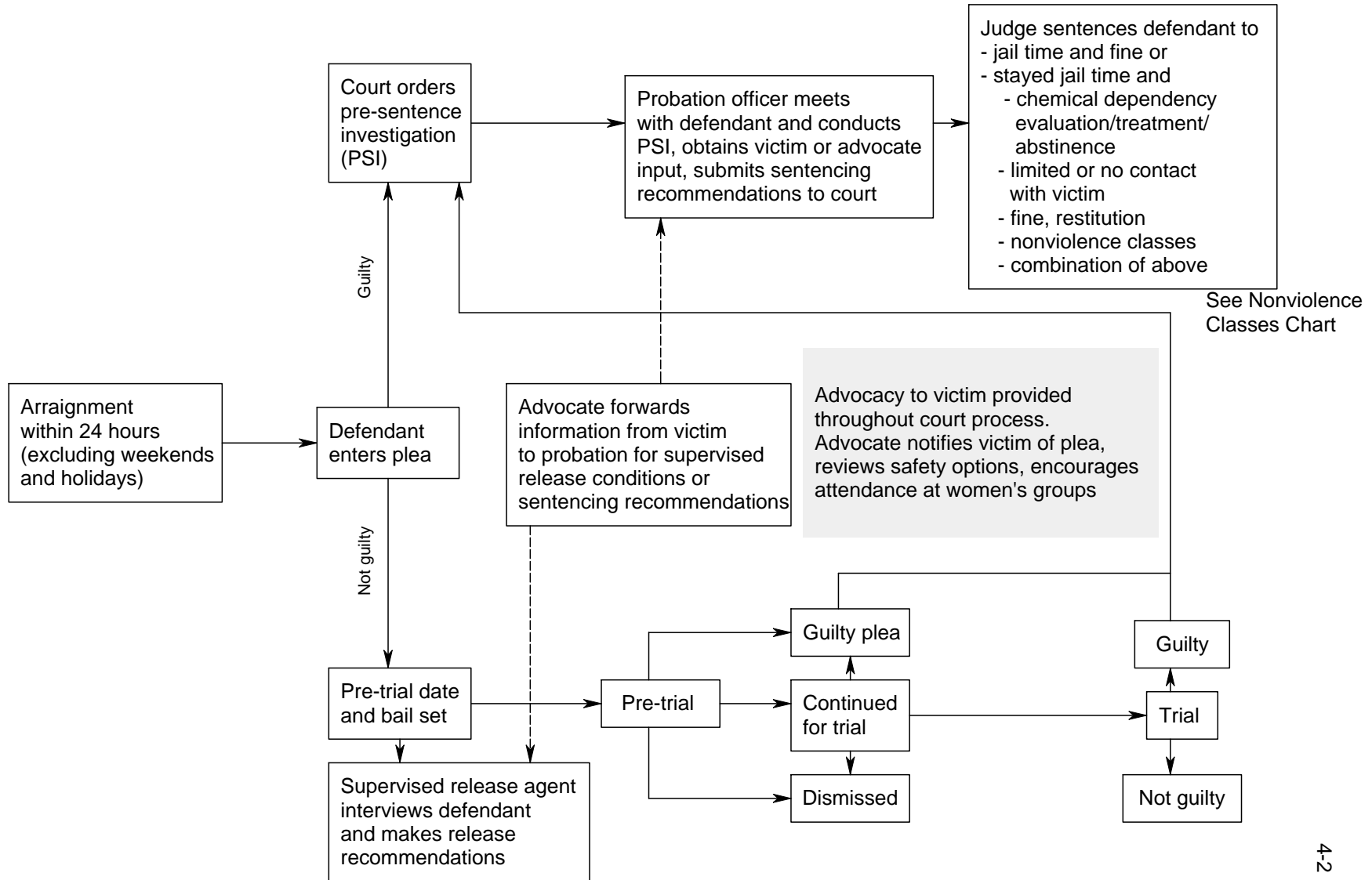
## LAW ENFORCEMENT AND INITIAL ADVOCACY RESPONSE



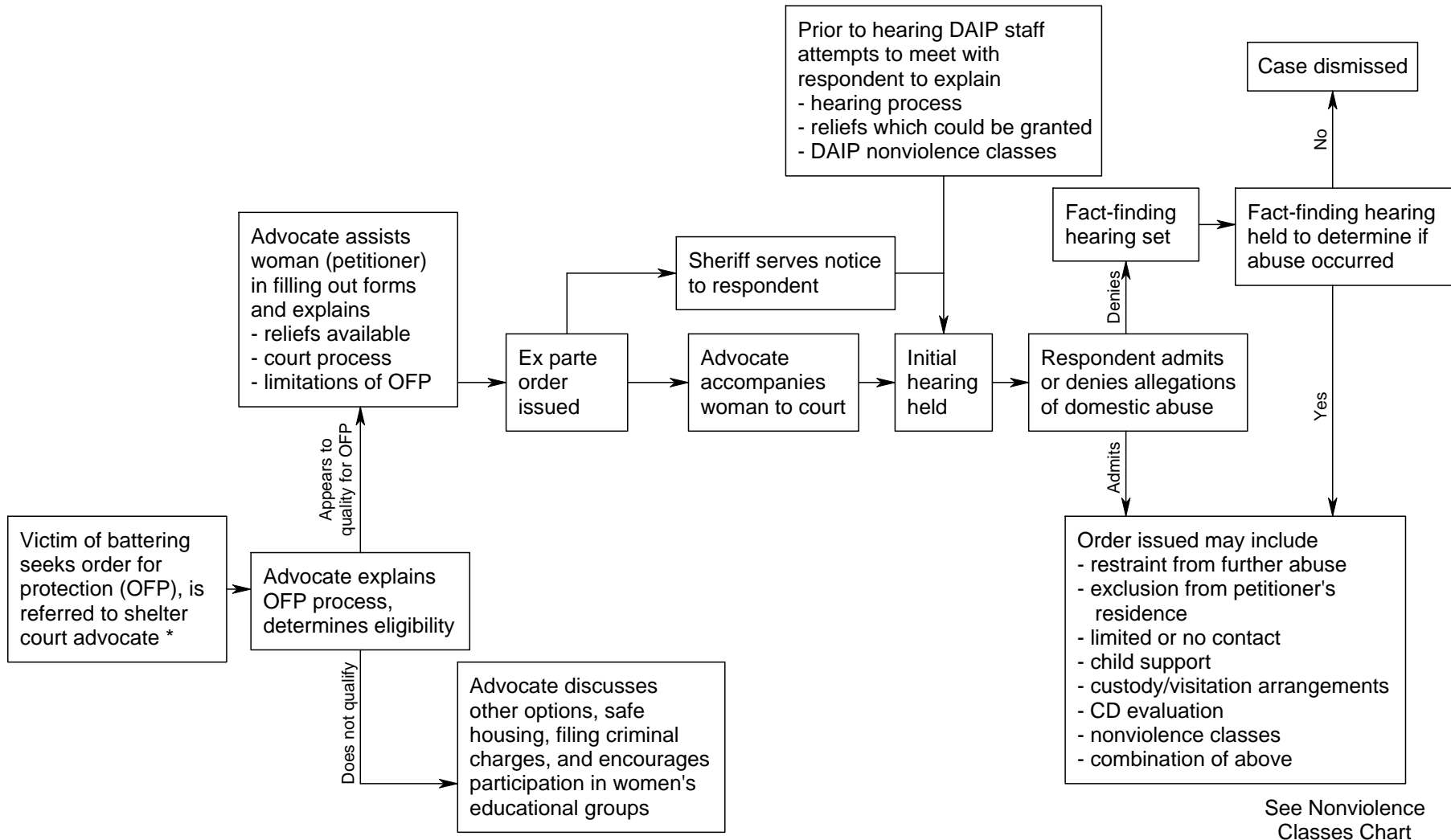
\* Minnesota law allows jailers to hold suspects arrested for domestic assault up to 48 hours.

\*\* Advocate sends victim's history of violence report to court for use in setting release conditions, conducting pre-sentencing investigations.

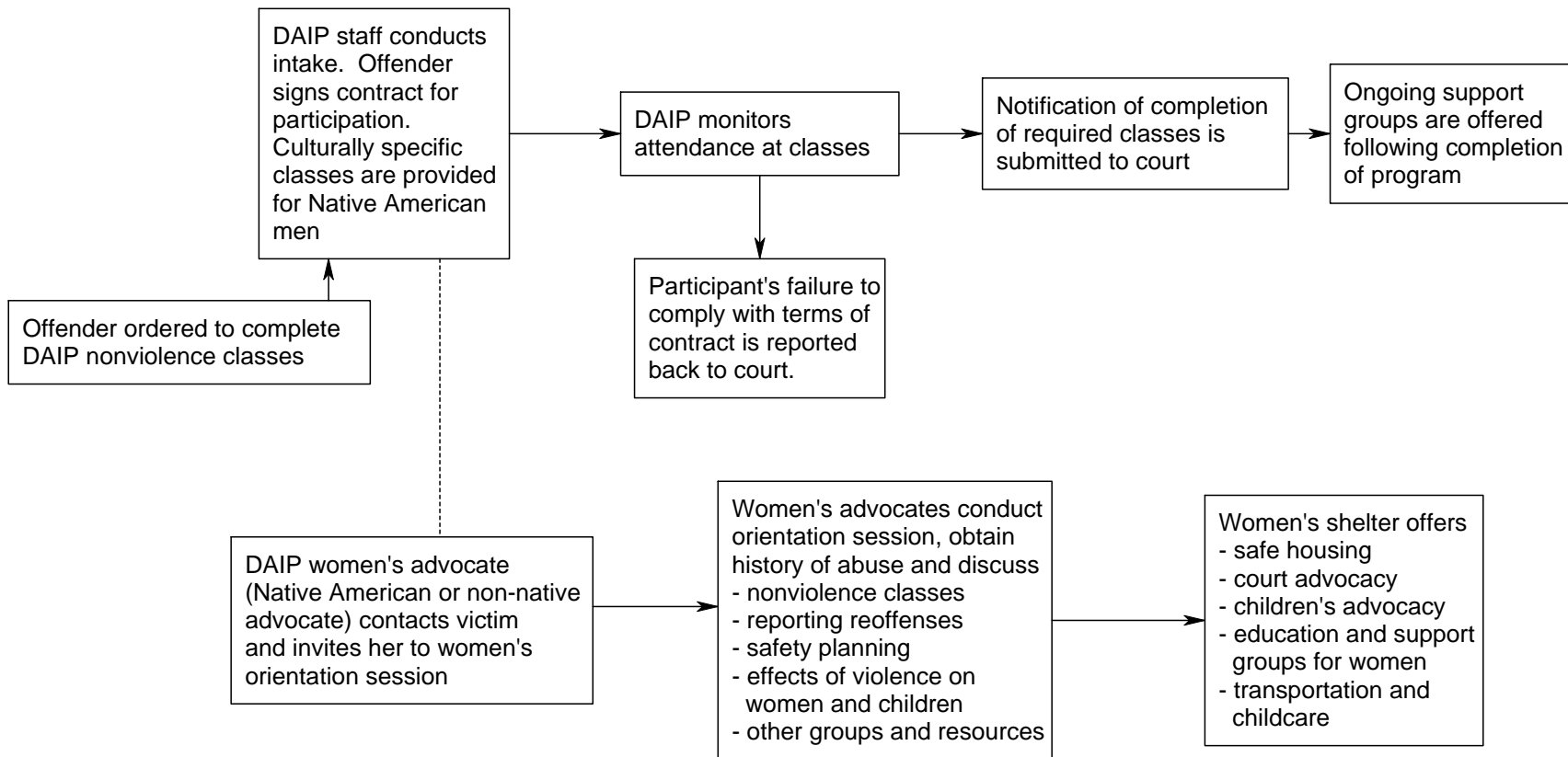
## CIVIL COURT AND ADVOCACY RESPONSE
