



Motive Checklist

Those with Survival-Motive tend to:

- Believe they would not be okay if their victim were to leave them
- Seems to be truly remorseful after being violent to their victim
- Display extreme jealousy
- Accuse their victim of having affairs
- Blame their victim for how they feel about themselves
- Express abandonment, betrayal, or humiliation by their victim
- Threaten/Attempt suicide
- Go into a rage
- Threaten to harm their victim
- Threaten to harm their or their victim's children or extended family
- Threaten to harm their victim's pets
- Feel they are not worthy of their victim's love
- Struggle with perceived inadequacies from their childhood
- Have a Dr. Jekyll & Mr. Hyde personality
- Need to know where their victim is at all times
- Try to pick their victim's friends

Those with Material-Motive tend to have Entitlement Motive PLUS:

- Expect the victim to financially support them
- Believe women are interchangeable
- Have little/no jealousy
- Have little to no reciprocity in the relationship with their victim
- Might force victim to sexually serve others

Those with Sadistic-Motive tend to:

- Enjoy hurting their victim
- Plot and plan over an extended period
- Attempt to own their victim: mind, body, and soul
- Fantasize about torturing their victim in some way
- Fantasize about killing their victim, family, or children
- Lock their victim in a room, in or out of the house, or tie them up
- Play mind games with their victim: attempt to make them think they are going crazy
- Keep their victim from taking important medicine/ experiment with effect of medications
- Make victim and/or children go without food/water?
- Suffer from impotence/ must torture victim to get aroused
- Threaten to harm victim's pets
- Harm pets
- Torture the victim in some way

Those with Entitlement-Motive tend to:

- Make all of the important decisions
- Expect that their needs will come first
- Believe that it is the victim's responsibility to serve them
- Believe they have the right to be violent if they don't get their way
- Make all the rules in the relationship
- Live by double-standards
- Believe they have the right to boss the victim around
