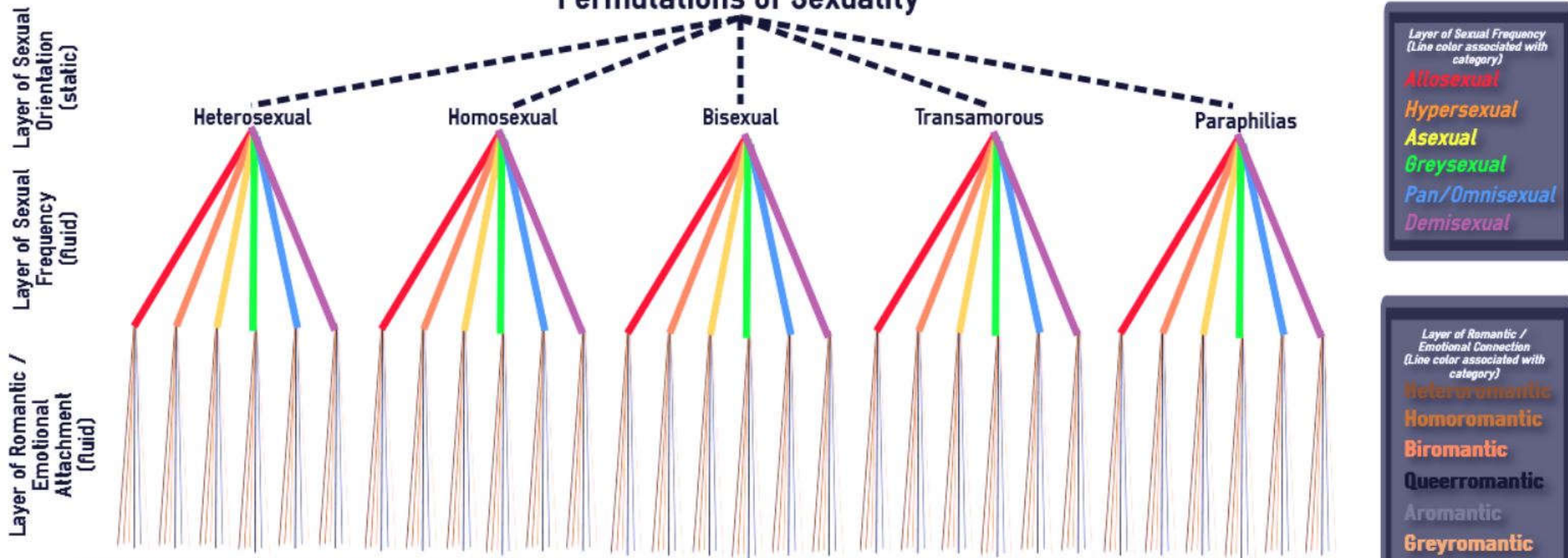


Permutations of Sexuality



*Layer of Sexual Frequency
(Line color associated with category)*

- Allosexual

*Layer of Romantic / Emotional Connection
(Line color associated with category)*

This graphic represents the 180 kinds of sexuality. Sexuality is made up of a combination of sexual orientation, desired frequency, and emotional attachment. The bottom points of the tree graph represent each sexuality. To determine types, follow the path from top to bottom. For example, someone could be heterosexual (top of chart), allosexual (red line), and heteroromantic (dark brown line). Or on the other end of the tree, could be paraphiliac (top of chart), demisexual (purple line), and greyromantic (tan line). Many of these sexualities are rare, but that does not mean they do not exist. Taking the time to learn about and honor someone's sexuality demonstrates respect, regard, and care for the individual. Understanding the vast amount of variety beyond a binary understanding of sexuality can also offer clarity during discussions. Note this is specifically about sexuality, not gender, and while there are people who are specifically transamorous and/or transromantic, gender identity is separate from sexuality. The rainbow colors are used to honor the LGBTQ+ flag, and are keyed to layers of frequency. The shades of brown and grey are keyed to the layer of emotional attachment.
